POSSIBLE ACTIVITIES	<p><u>Before and during exchange</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mapping My Community – see <u>warm-up activity linked above.</u> • City Souvenirs – Students will <u>collect and/or photograph or draw souvenirs to ‘send’ to their partner class, explaining the significance of the items to the city or culture. The exchange student can also ‘bring’ souvenirs back to their home town to show their class.</u> • City Legends – Students will <u>translate and tell or read legends or other famous stories about their hometown</u> • Virtual Tourguide – Students will <u>create tours of their city. These could be in video format, photographs with explanations, a blog or wiki site, a Google My Map with significant points selected and described with pictures (historical significance, cultural significance, social significance).</u>
